



Renew Therapeutic Riding Center Scholarship Policy

Renew TRC exists to serve those in our community through the physical, cognitive, and emotional benefits of equine assisted services. We believe in the incredible experiences offered at the barn and its life-changing impact. As a result, we aim to make our services accessible!

Although the \$40 lesson cost to our participants is already at a significantly lessened rate than its \$200 value (based on the 2025-2026 budget and cost projections), we are passionate about offering scholarship opportunities for families who may benefit in order to participate. Although the \$40 tuition covers a small percentage of our actual cost, Renew strives to keep costs to families reasonable by hosting fundraisers such as our Denim & Diamonds and other unique events throughout the year.

Applications for scholarship assistance are available through the link on our website. We offer 2 scholarship options:

- 1) **Full Coverage:** *If you request and are approved to receive coverage for the full amount of your lesson costs, you will be provided full scholarship for 4 out of 6 sessions in a calendar year. Scholarship funds are automatically applied to Sessions 1,2,3, and 5.*
- 2) **Partial Coverage:** *If you request and are approved to receive coverage for half the cost of your lessons, you will be provided partial scholarship for all 6 sessions that we offer in a calendar year.*

We also ask that families who receive scholarship assistance maintain at least 80% attendance in an effort to make best use of donated scholarship funds. If your participant has less than 80% attendance, scholarship coverage will be reevaluated. Lesson credits are not offered for scholarship students to ensure donated funding is available to support students in need throughout the entire year.
